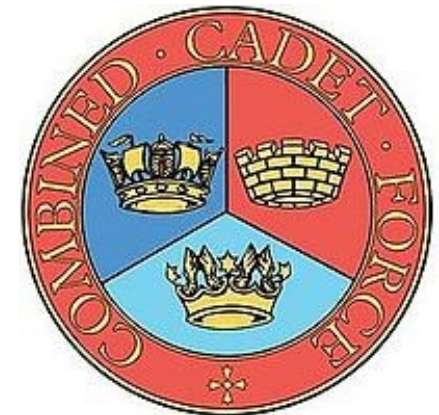

Basic Infantry Dice

- Full Red Star
- MOI Cadre
- Ex First Steps
- Ex Simba Dice
- GP Rifle Shoot

Advanced Infantry Bayonet

- Basic Infantry Dice
- CFIT Cadre
- Ex Golden Lion
- DS position on Basic Infantry Exercise
- LSW Shoot
- Infantry Written Test

On completion of the Advanced Infantry qualification, cadets will be eligible for Instructor positions within Recruits Section, Basic and Advanced Infantry sections.

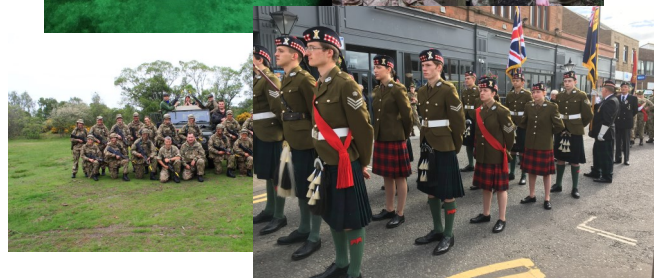
Kit to be worn for CCF
