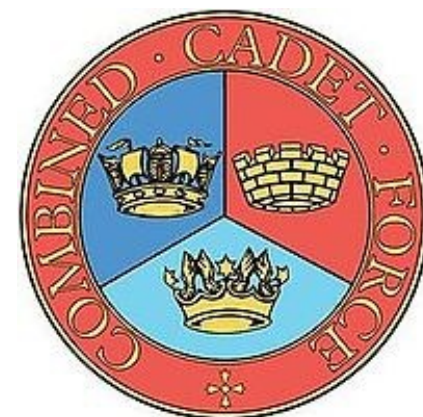

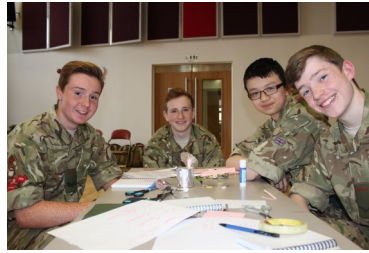
Where to go if you had a great time and want to continue with the cadets
