Instrumental Tuition 2020/2021

Music tuition at Dollar is provided by a highly qualified team of visiting freelance specialists. They work with the Music Department, who provide additional support for timetabling, review lessons, maintenance of waiting lists, ABRSM/Trinity exam entries etc. Those currently receiving tuition in school need not re-apply as lessons will continue until written notice is received.

The Instructors have collectively agreed the rate for session 2020/2021 which is £18.50 per thirty-minute lesson.

Co-Curricular Ensembles 2020/21

One particularly rewarding and beneficial element of playing a musical instrument or studying voice is participating in an ensemble. There is a wide variety of ensembles on offer at Dollar Academy with something to suit everyone at whatever stage or ability they are. Briefly, the groups on offer are as follows:

Prep 4-5

Prep Orchestra, Prep Choir, Recorder Ensemble

Junior1 and Junior2

Junior Orchestra, Junior Choir, Ukulele Group, Samba Band

Form I and II

2nd Orchestra, DAJO (jazz ensemble), String Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Form I/II Choir, Ukulele Group

Form III-VI

1st Orchestra, String Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Mixed Voice Choir, Chamber Choir, DAJO (jazz ensemble)

All pupils receiving instrumental or vocal lessons are encouraged to involve themselves as fully as possible in the co-curricular programme with a suggestion that **all** pupils should join at least one ensemble.
